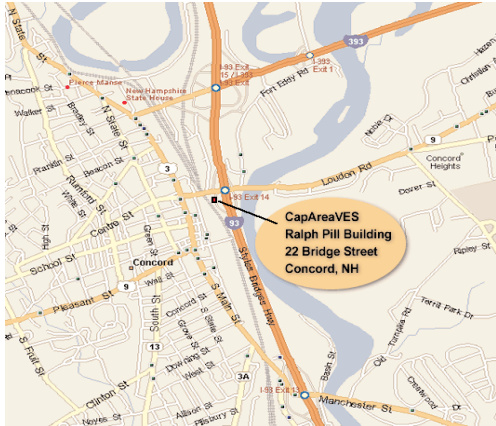


DIRECTIONS



From I-93 North, take Exit 14, take a left at the end of the exit. At 3rd set of lights make a left. We are located on the ground floor of the Ralph Pill Building.

From I-93 South, take Exit 14, take a right at the end of the exit, and then an immediate left. We are located on the ground floor of the Ralph Pill Building.

From downtown Concord, go EAST on Bridge Street out of Concord, then take the first right. We are located on the ground floor of the Ralph Pill Building.

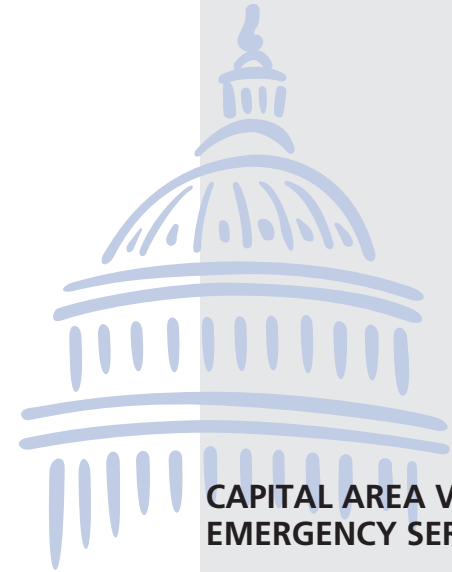

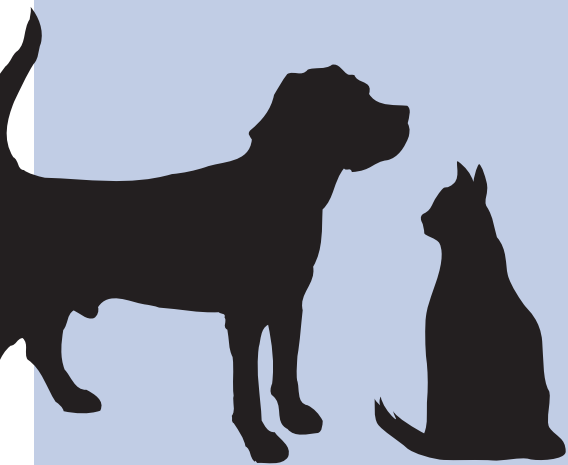

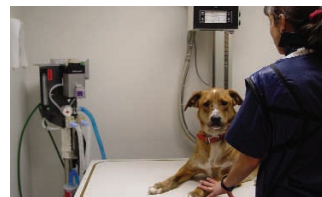
